The purpose of the Joinville Migrant Assistance Network booklet is to help migrants, workers who provide assistance to migrants, institutions, and society in general to learn about services, programs and other activities for migrants.

The booklet was created by the Coordination of Policies for Women and Human Rights, of the Citizenship and Human Rights Department under the Social Assistance Secretariat, with the support of the International Organization for Migration - IOM. The document is available in the following languages: Portuguese, French, English, Spanish, and Haitian Creole.

# About the International Organization for Migration (IOM):

IOM is committed to the principle that safe, orderly and humane migration benefits all migrants and host societies. As an intergovernmental organization, IOM works with its partners in the public sector, the private sector, civil society and the international community to help address the growing challenges of managing migration, to foster an understanding of migration issues, to promote social and economic development through migration and to ensure respect for the human dignity and well-being of migrants.

This booklet was developed under the framework of the project Opportunities - Integration in Brazil (Oportunidades - Integração no Brasil), an initiative of the International Organization for Migration (IOM), funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). With the objective of promoting durable solutions for the economic integration of Venezuelan nationals and vulnerable migrants from other countries neighboring Brazil, the project includes initiatives for labor insertion and integration, training and capacity building, promotion of entrepreneurship, and access to information and rights.

## Some concepts:

#### Migrant

An umbrella term, not defined under international law, reflecting the common lay understanding of a person who moves away from his or her place of usual residence, whether within a country or across an international border, temporarily or permanently, and for a variety of reasons (10M).

<sup>1</sup> There is no universally accepted definition of "migrant". The present definition was developed by IOM for its own purposes and is not intended to imply or create any new legal category. Two approaches are generally adopted to define the term "migrant": the inclusive approach, followed among others by IOM, which considers the term "migrant" as an umbrella term that covers all forms of movements; and the residual approach, which excludes from the term "migrant" those fleeing from war or persecution.

# International Migration

Movements of persons who leave their countries of origin or habitual residence to settle, either permanently or temporarily, in another country. Consequently, it involves the crossing of international borders (IOM).

#### **Refugee Applicants**

People who have applied to a country for recognition of their refugee status and are awaiting its decision.

#### Immigrant

A person who is a national of another country or a stateless person who works or resides and settles temporarily or permanently in another country (Law 13,445, 2017);

#### Refugee

A person who has received special protection from the Brazilian State, as provided for in Law 9.474, of July 22, 1997. People who were forced to leave their country because their lives or integrity were at risk, and who cannot return to their country of origin because they do not have state protection (UNHCR).



#### **Stateless**

A person who is not recognized as a national of any state, according to its legislation.


